COVID-19 Policies

Updated: July 28,2020

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic we have new policies at Kinderwood. Upon arrival an office personal will take your child's temperature. If your child is scanning in at 100 or more, they will not be able to attend. If a student develops 1 or more symptoms of COVID-19 they will be sent home and can not return until symptom free for 72 hrs. In some cases, we require a doctor's note explaining the symptoms or a COVID-19 test. Anyone who enters the building must wear a mask and fill out our COVID questioner. All staff members are required to wear a face mask at all times. We ask that all families be truthful and forthcoming if a possible exposure or symptoms of COVID-19 .

What is the drop off procedures?

1. When you arrive at Kinderwood you will see red dots in front of the door. These are 6ft markers for appropriate social distancing. Please stay on the markers until the person in front of you has completely left their marker.
2. Once you are in the Lobby you will either use your own pen or use hand sanitizer and the school pen to sign your child in.
3. An office personal will do a temperature scan and a visual wellness check of your child(ren)
4. Office personnel will then take your child(ren) to wash hands and join their class for a full day of activities.
5. You will leave the lobby and have a great day.

What is the pick up procedures?

1. When you arrive at Kinderwood you will see red dots in front of the door. These are 6ft markers for appropriate social distancing. Please stay on the markers until the person in front of you has completely left their marker.
2. While in line please be sure to check the front door for your child(ren) daily report. Infant daily reports will be sent home with their belongings.
3. Once you are in the Lobby you will either use your own pen or use hand sanitizer and the school pen to sign your child(ren) out.
4. An office personnel will then collect your child(ren) and bring them to the office.
5. You and your children will leave and have a happy evening.

Classroom Procedures:

In the classroom, children are split in small groups. The groups will rotate from outside to inside. Groups will not exceed 8:1 ratio. When napping, students are napping 6 ft apart in a head to toe layout. After every nap time each mat is wiped down with a disinfectant wipe. Each classroom is section off to practice social distancing. Each section will have a day where it is open and closed to students. After students are done playing with toys they are disinfected in a bleach and water solution. At the end of the day the last teacher in the room will spray everything with a disinfectant spray. All surfaces will be thoroughly cleaned with disinfectant before and after each day, according to the manufacturer's directions. All common surfaces are disinfected more than 3 times a day.
